Your pharmacy network options are changing in 2017

Your <plan name> plan helps you pay lower prices for your medicines. Your plan has contracted with certain pharmacies for in-network coverage. When you use these pharmacies, you often have lower out-of-pocket costs.

Beginning January 1, 2017, <Pharmacy Name> will no longer be a part of your <Plan Name> pharmacy network. *This includes all CVS-owned pharmacies and CVS pharmacies in Target stores.* 

## What this means for you

To pay less for your medicines or to maximize your pharmacy benefits, if you use CVS as your pharmacy you will need to switch to a new in-network pharmacy beginning **January 1, 2017**.

## It's easy to switch your prescriptions

Simply choose a new in-network pharmacy and transfer your prescriptions by doing <u>one of the</u> following:

- 1. Take your prescription bottle/bag to your new pharmacy. They will contact your current pharmacy to transfer your prescription.
- 2. Call your new pharmacy and ask them to contact your current pharmacy for your prescription information.
- 3. Ask your doctor to call your new pharmacy with your prescription information.
